

Directions:

1. Drive north along Hwy 400 to Hwy 11 North towards Bracebridge and exit at Hwy 118.
2. Travel East along Hwy 118 right through into Haliburton. You will get to a set of lights, which is the centre of town.
3. Continue through town and along Hwy 118 as it heads up into the hills.
4. Turn right onto Glamorgan Road, also known as County Road #3 and travel along this road for about 5 km.
5. Just before you get to the sign that says Minnicock Lake Road you will see a school bus stop and that will indicate that you are just about to arrive at Minnicock Lake Road. Turn Left onto Minnicock Lake Road and travel about 3 km.. This is a hilly roadway.
6. At Hubbard and Montgomery Road you turn right and at this point the road becomes a private road. You may see a sign that states this road is closed during the winter season, but it is not. It is plowed regularly.** Drive less than a km along Hubbard and Montgomery Road and turn right at Aspen Lane.
7. WE are # 1033 and I advise that you leave your vehicles at the top of the driveway and walk in during the winter season. Otherwise, drive down and park. DO NOT PARK BEYOND THE LOGS. THIS IS THE BED OF THE SEPTIC SYSTEM. ANY SIGNIFICANT WEIGHT ON TOP OF THIS AREA WILL DESTROY THE SYSTEM.
8. **NOTE DURING THE WINTER SEASON: Hubbard. Montgomery Road and Aspen Lane are private roads and we have them plowed regularly. They are single lane roads and should be used if your car has winter tires only. Otherwise, keep the cars on Lake Minnicock Road and walk in.
9. Please note that the sign for Aspen Lane is on the left side of Hubbard and Montgomery and often is not noticed. My husband put up another sign for Aspen Lane and so it should be quite clear where you turn right.
